LICENSED OCCUPATIONS IN THE PEST CONTROL SECTOR

PEST MANAGEMENT TECHNICIAN

Holders of a Pest Management Technicians Licence WA are able to undertake all areas of pest management so long as they complete required training specific to knowledge that falls outside of the Certificate III qualification. There is a legal requirement for a person to hold a current licence and business registration under the Health (Pesticides) Regulations 2011. There is a two-tiered system of licensing Pest Management Technicians in Western Australia. This system was designed to meet the requirements of industry, government and the community.

Legislation for this area comes under the Health (Pesticide) Regulations 1956 WA pursuant to the Health Act 1911 WA under the licensing authority of the Western Australian Department of Health who issues licenses for domestic, commercial, horticultural, forestry, agricultural aerial operators. New legislation requiring industry members to carry a plastic photo licence was introduced in Dec 2007 and became law in Feb 2011
